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## **Case History**

In the U.S., at least \$2.4 billion in criminal fines and penalties have been imposed, and some automotive executives and companies have plead guilty to criminal charges, as a result of alleged bid-rigging and fixing prices concerning various Automotive Parts. Customers, car repair shops, and other businesses have filed class action lawsuits in Canada alleging the same wrongful conduct. To date, the Class has reached settlements with many of the Defendants. The filing deadline to participate in the First Round of Settlements totaling approximately \$25.6 million (CDN) was June 12, 2020 and the filing deadline to participate in the Second Round of Settlements totaling approximately \$78.4 million (CDN) was October 30, 2023.

\*This Summary, however, pertains to the approximate \$59.6 million (CDN) and \$14.3 million (USD) recovered in the Third Round of Settlements (see below for more information about these settlements). The guilty pleas and magnitude of the criminal fines in the U.S., however, enhance the likelihood that additional civil settlements will be reached in Canada.
