

**Class Action Summary**  
**Automotive Parts Canada Class Action Settlements**

*This is not an official Court Notice. Information contained in this Summary is subject to change.*

If you, your dealership or business purchased Automotive Parts in Canada on or after **January 1, 1995**, you may be entitled to participate in the approximate **\$120,620,056 (CDN)** and **\$24,419,500 (USD)** recovered ***thus far*** in class action settlements.\*

**First Round Claim Filing Deadline: The deadline to file a claim has passed.**

**Second Round Claim Filing Deadline: No Claim Forms are available at this time.  
 No claim filing deadline has been set.**

**Eligible Class Members:** Individuals, dealerships or entities who, on or after January 1, 1995, purchased or leased a new or used vehicle in Canada; purchased a new or used vehicle for import into Canada; or purchased an “Automotive Part” as listed below under “Eligible Products” (or a component of one) in Canada. These class actions include direct and indirect purchases from the “Defendants” listed on the next page.

**Case History:** In the U.S., at least \$2.4 billion in criminal fines and penalties have been imposed, and some automotive executives and companies have plead guilty to criminal charges, as a result of alleged bid-rigging and fixing prices concerning various Automotive Parts. Customers, car repair shops, and other businesses have filed class action lawsuits in Canada alleging the same wrongful conduct. To date, the Class has reached settlements with many of the Defendants for a total amount of approximately \$145.5 (CDN) and \$18.5 million (USD). The filing deadline to participate in the First Round of Settlements totaling approximately \$25.6 million (CDN) was June 12, 2020. **\*This Summary, however, pertains to the approximate \$120.6 million (CDN) and \$24.4 million (USD) recovered in the Second Round of Settlements (see below for more information about these settlements and claim forms are not available at this time). The guilty pleas and magnitude of the criminal fines in the U.S., however, enhance the likelihood that additional civil settlements will be reached in Canada.**
