Case History

Numerous class action lawsuits were filed over the past several years alleging the Defendants conspired to allocate markets and artificially raise, fix, maintain and/or stabilize the price of the generic pharmaceutical drugs listed on the attached page in violation of federal antitrust laws. The class has now entered into settlements with Breckenridge in the amount of \$1 million (*please contact FRS for information about this more limited settlement class) and Apotex in the amount of \$5.537 million. These settlements are pending final approval. The litigation is ongoing against the remaining Defendants so it is possible that additional funds may become available to the class if additional settlements are reached in the future. FRS will update this Summary as the case progresses and new information becomes available.
