

Class Action Summary

Generic Pharmaceutical Indirect Reseller

Antitrust Class Action

If your hospital or privately held pharmacy purchased various generic pharmaceutical products on or after **January 1, 2010**, an antitrust class action lawsuit alleging price fixing may affect you.

Eligible Class Members: If certified, eligible Class Members include all dispensers of drugs (including hospitals and independent pharmacies, but excluding all pharmacies owned and operated by publicly traded companies), in the “Eligible Jurisdictions” (listed below), that, from January 1, 2010 to the present, purchased the Defendants’ (listed below) generic “Drugs at Issue” (listed on the attached page).

“Eligible Jurisdictions”: The Eligible Jurisdictions include: AL, AK, AZ, AR, CA, CO, CT, DE, FL, GA, ID, IA, KS, LA, ME, MD, MA, MI, MN, MS, MO, MT, NE, NV, NH, NJ, NM, NY, NC, ND, OR, PA, RI, SD, TN, TX, UT, VT, VA, WA, WV, WI, WY as well as the District of Columbia and Puerto Rico.

Case History: Numerous class action lawsuits were filed over the past several years alleging the Defendants conspired to allocate markets and artificially raise, fix, maintain and/or stabilize the price of the generic pharmaceutical drugs listed on the attached page in violation of federal antitrust laws. These lawsuits were consolidated in the Eastern District of Pennsylvania, and the litigation is ongoing at this time. It is impossible to predict the outcome, but money may become available to eligible class members if the class is certified and a settlement is reached with one or more of the Defendants in the future. FRS will update this Summary as the case progresses and new information becomes available.

If a monetary settlement is obtained, information about it will be available from Class Counsel. You also may visit the Court-approved website once one is established.
